

MEETING AT SANDRIDGE.

SATURDAY OCT. 15TH 1949.

The secretary remarked upon the difficulty of getting a meeting at Hatfield and put forward the suggestion made by Hatfield rings that a meeting be held there one Thursday night. This proposition was discussed & was felt to be impracticable.

There was no other business and the meeting was closed with a vote of thanks to the Vice for taking the chair & for the use of the bells.
